DBDM Teacher Meeting #1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create/select Common Formative Assessments (CFAs) for unit. • Agree on scoring method (e.g., scoring guide, rubric, etc.) • Determine cut scores for CFA • Determine subgroups(s) population data needed. • Celebrate success 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Administer first CFA: pre-assessment. • Score the pre-assessment. • Chart students by performance levels. • To save time at Meeting 2, analysis of classroom student data should occur (strengths, misconceptions, and inferences can be listed.) • Model and each using ETLPs and selected strategy(ies) until Meeting 2.
DBDM Teacher Meeting #2 (Repeat these steps until the summative assessment is given)	<p>Steps 2 – 6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Analyze group data from CFAs and examine for student growth. • Prioritize needs for each performance level. • Set SMART goal(s). • Select Common strategy(ies) for each performance level. • Determine results indicators. • Set data for next assessment. • Celebrate success. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Model and teach using ELTPs and selected strategy(ies) until Meeting 3+. • Monitor student progress through formative assessments. • Provide descriptive/productive feedback to students. • Administer next CFA. • Score the CFA. • Chart students by performance levels. • To save time at Meeting 3+, analysis of classroom student data should occur (strengths, misconceptions, errors, and inferences may be listed). <p><i>Repeat this process through all assessments.</i></p>
